PURPOSE OF CHALLENGE:

To assess the contestant’s ability in sewing construction related to the field of women’s fashion technology.

SKILLS AND KNOWLEDGE TO BE TESTED:

- 1) Using **New Look (Simplicity) pattern # 2286** for the purposes of this competition, we ask that you only use the options/modifications listed on the pattern package. Judging criteria will be based upon specific garment assembly techniques and fabric selection.
- 2) Please arrive with your pattern pinned and ready to cut on the morning of the contest.
 - **The garment to be sewn for the competition will be a misses skirt in your size (view B).**
- 3) Competitors will be judged on pattern layout. **DO NOT** cut prior to the contest. On the day of the competition, competitors will be required to construct their garment.

The **Garment Information Sheet** (see attached) must accompany your pattern layout on the morning of the competition.

Competitors are encouraged to sew a practice garment at home or school, in order to establish assembly techniques and timelines for completion.

EQUIPMENT AND MATERIALS:

Supplied by Committee:

- Pattern (one per registrant)
- ironing boards
- domestic irons
- domestic sergers
- Sewing machine, needles and bobbins

Competitor Must Supply:

- Competitors will be required to contact NW Skills SLyman@GPRC.ab.ca for their **Learn to Sew (Simplicity) # 2286 pattern** and are required to select and purchase fabric(s) and notions of their choice.
 - **Fabric**
 - Price of fabric is **NOT** to exceed \$15.00/meter.
 - Competitors may choose to use the same fabric or contrasting fabric for pockets.
 - Total of fabric choice must not exceed 1.5 meters long and may be either 45" or 60" wide.
 - A trim of your choice can be chosen for pocket opening.
 - **Competitors should purchase garment notions prior to the competition.**
 - **Notions to include:**
 - 1.5 meters of 1" wide elastic, thread.
 - Competitors will be reimbursed \$40.00 to assist in recovering the cost of fabric and notions.
 - Equipment and supplies needed to construct garment (e.g.: tape measure, pins, scissors, marking equipment, rotary cutter, mats, ect.)
 - Appropriate hanger for your garment.

JUDGING CRITERIA:

Competitors will be judged on the following criteria:

- Pattern Layout
- Fabric Choice
- Choice of Construction Techniques
- Skill in Using Construction Techniques
- Design Details
- Finishing
- Pressing

IMPORTANT GENERAL INFORMATION

CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS:

Competitors are expected to wear closed toed shoes, have long hair tied back, no flowing sleeves, and no scarves or long jewelry. No cell phones in competition area.

TIE BREAKING PROCEDURE:

The highest score in the "Finishing" section of the judging form will be used as a tie breaker.
