**GENERAL DESCRIPTION**

Enable industry to view the level of skill taught within the secondary institutions, and encourage interaction between the two sectors. This working relationship will help ensure that the skills students gain in secondary education meet the demands of industry. The competition also challenges students in hairstyling and promotes this career area.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

The level of this competition will allow the young stylists to demonstrate their technical skills and creative ability in the following test: Creative Bridal Style (Long Hair) Evening.

**EQUIPMENT AND MATERIALS**

**Supplied by the committee:**

- The committee will supply tables, mirrors, mannequins and mannequin stands, extension cords, etc.
- The length of all mannequin hair will be 18"
- Hands must be washed (or sanitized) before starting the competition. The committee will supply a large bottle of sanitizer.

**Supplied by the contestant:**

- Contestant must supply their own tools and products (no sharing) Suggested supplies: professional products, Barbicide spray, bobby pins, elastics, spray bottle, curling iron, flat iron, hot rollers, tail combs, brushes, sectioning clips, etc. (hair dryers must not require more than 1800 watts).
- Ornamentation (i.e. complements the design, does not cover more than 1/3 head, demonstrates pre-planning and creativity – does not include hair extensions and hair pieces).
- Professional styling products must be used (color sprays are not permitted and all product labels must be covered).

**SAFETY**

The health, safety and welfare of all individuals involved with the regional skills competition are of vital importance. Safety is a condition of participation and shall not be sacrificed for the sake of expediency. Competitors are required to follow all industry standards during the competition. At the discretion of the judges and technical committees, any competitor can be denied the right to participate should they not have the required proper safety equipment and/or act in an unsafe manner that can cause harm to themselves or others.

## **INTERMEDIATE CONTEST**

### **Creative Bridal Style (Long Hair) Evening**

#### **Objective:**

- The contestant will use their imagination in order to create a style that must be combed into an up style showing a bridal theme which displays their artistic ability.
- The competitors will handle hair confidently, brush, comb, and part hair correctly.
- Hair must be completely dry and brushed through at the beginning of the contest.

#### **JUDGING CRITERIA**

- The degree of difficulty, inspiration & creativity, balance and form, and clean finish will form the basis of the judging for this competition.
- Ornamentation compliments the design.
- Ornamentation does not cover more than 1/3 of the head.
- Ornamentation demonstrates pre-planning & creativity.
- All judging will be performed according to a criterion based system. The contestant with the most points from the test will be the winner, the second highest mark will be placed second, and the third highest mark will be third.
- Demerits may be given for any rule infractions.
- Any communication between audience and competitor during contest times may be seen as coaching and could cause demerits to be awarded.
- Mannequin will be displayed on the table facing the mirror with a regular stand.
- The contestant demonstrated professionalism in overall appearance, as in tasteful attire and make-up (no exposed midriiffs, spaghetti straps, low cut tops, shorts, jeans, mini-skirts, etc.) Clean and comfortable work attire as would be worn in a modern hair salon. Also, appropriate footwear must be worn (no platform, high heeled, or open toed shoes).
- Time allowed for completion is 1.5 hours.
