Gold medalists at the PSCC will become part of Team Alberta and will compete at the Skills Canada National Competition in Edmonton on May 14-15, 2012.

## Register for the North West Regional Skills Canada Competition

**Registration for the North West RSCC opens on Monday, February 13, 2012 at 8am.**

Registration for the Provincial Skills Canada Competition opens Monday, February 27, 2012 at 8am.

Registration is administered on a first come, first serve basis at SkillsAlberta.com:

- If you do not already have a login name and password, register to become a **Skills School** at **SkillsAlberta.com**. Once registered you will be emailed a Login Name and Password for your school.
- Go to SkillsAlberta.com and select **Login** from the top right side of the homepage
- Enter the Login Name and Password provided to you when you became a Skills School. Select **Login!**
- Once logged in, select **Register Competitors**.
- Select the **Program** you wish to enter *i.e.* North West Regional Skills Canada Competition.
- Select the **Event** you would like to reserve a spot for *i.e.* Carpentry, Culinary Arts, etc. Click **Register Students**.
- **Indicate the number of spots** you would like to reserve for that event. Most events accept only one competitor per school. Select **OK**.
- If a competitor spot is available in the selected event, it will indicate that your registration was successful.
- If spots are not available in the selected event or if you would like to request a spot for an additional competitor, select the **Waiting List Request** link on the left side of the page and **Add Request**. Additional Competitor Requests will be granted March 21 through to April 13.
- Registration for competitor spots closes on March 16.

All competitor personal contact information, including contact information pertaining to additional spots that have been granted, must be submitted online 2 weeks before the competition. Release forms must also be faxed in 2 weeks before the competition.

To enter your student's name:

- Once logged in click **Competitor Information**.
- Select the Program - North West Regional Skills Canada Competition.

**Registration is offered on a first come, first serve basis. One competitor, per school, per event for most competitions, until a competition event is full. Should a competition not be full, additional spots will be granted from the waiting list requests using the same process.**

**Registration is \$30** (Includes; A complimentary snack foods and beverages both Thursday & Friday evenings).

**Signed consent forms and registration fees must be in prior to competition**, however competitor whose fees and consent forms are in by April 5 will be eligible for a prize draw.

**Fee Refund** - Refunds may be made, prior to April 5, for a cancelled registration due to an exceptional circumstance. After April 5 no refunds will be provided.
