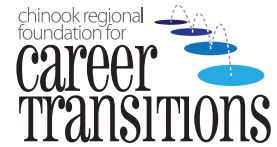

By taking their skills out of the traditional classroom setting, students gain an appreciation for where their skills can take them, and are encouraged to reach for their personal best.

\*To compete at the Provincial Skills Canada Competition in Auto Service, Cabinet Making, Carpentry, Culinary Arts, Hairstyling - Junior, Hairstyling - Intermediate, TV/Video Production and Welding students must qualify at their Regional Skills Canada Competition.

In 2012, nine Regional Skills Canada Competition (RSCC) will take place across Alberta. The top performers at the South West RSCC will earn a spot at the 20<sup>th</sup> Provincial Skills Canada Competition (PSCC), on May 10-11, 2012 at the Edmonton Expo Centre. Teachers may register their students directly into the PSCC for events that are not hosted at the regional level.

Gold medalists at the PSCC will become part of Team Alberta and will compete at the Skills Canada National Competition in Edmonton on May 14-15, 2012.

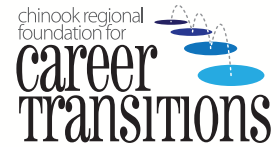

## Register for the South West Regional Skills Canada Competition

**Registration for the South West Regional Skills Canada Competition opens on Monday, February 13, 2012 at 8 am.**

Registration for the Provincial Skills Canada Competition opens Monday, February 27, 2012 at 8 am.

Registration is administered on a first come, first serve basis at [SkillsAlberta.com](http://SkillsAlberta.com):

- If you do not already have a login name and password, register to become a **Skills School** at **SkillsAlberta.com**. Once registered you will be emailed a Login Name and Password for your school.
- Go to [SkillsAlberta.com](http://SkillsAlberta.com) and select **Login** from the top right side of the homepage
- Enter the Login Name and Password provided to you when you became a Skills School. Select **Login!**
- Once logged in, select **Register Competitors**.
- Select the **Program** you wish to enter *i.e. South West Regional Skills Canada Competition*.
- Select the **Event** you would like to reserve a spot for *i.e. Carpentry, Culinary Arts, etc.* Click **Register Students**.
- **Indicate the number of spots** you would like to reserve for that event. Most events accept only one competitor per school. Select **OK**.
- If a competitor spot is available in the selected event, it will indicate that your registration was successful.
- If spots are not available in the selected event or if you would like to request a spot for an additional competitor, select the **Waiting List Request** link on the left side of the page and **Add Request**. Additional Competitor Requests will be granted by March 7.
- Registration for competitor spots closes on March 2.

All competitor personal contact information, including contact information pertaining to additional spots that have been granted, must be submitted online 2 weeks before the competition. Release forms must also be faxed in 2 weeks before the competition.

To enter your student's name:

- Once logged in click **Competitor Information**.
- Select the Program - South West Regional Skills Canada Competition.
