The GETT Gathering is an event of exploration and discovery for female high school students who are interested in learning more about the opportunities available to them in the trades and technologies. Female Industry Influencers from a variety of trade and technology backgrounds will share their stories, experiences, and knowledge to motivate students to think outside the box, try new things, and encourage them to discover and develop their interests and talents in areas they are passionate about.

We are committed to creating a space that is supportive of people who are typically underrepresented in these industries, and we welcome anyone who supports this mission.

## REGISTRATION & DROP DEADLINE

The registration fee is \$45/student and will be invoiced directly to your school following the event. Unfilled spots must be dropped by **April 6** to avoid being invoiced the full amount.

## BUS SUBSIDIES

We provide a bus subsidy to help offset the costs of attending the GETT Gathering for schools that bring 15 students or more. The subsidy can be applied for through a form link that will be emailed to you after attending the GETT Gathering. Subsidy amounts are based on the total kilometers of your trip:

**0-99KMS = \$100/bus**

**100-250KMS = \$200/bus**

**Over 250KMS = \$400/bus**



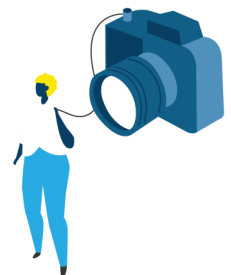
## THE DAY AT A GLANCE
