



ROBOTICS REGISTRATION 2021

Skills Canada Alberta is pleased to host Robotics as an event at the 2021 Provincial Skills Canada Competition (PSCC). All secondary contest areas in the 2021 PSCC will be hosted virtually, with students competing live from their own school. The Robotics competition will be held on **April 14th, 2021**. The exact time of the competition and information on how to take part virtually will be included in the Contest Description. The Contest Description for Robotics will be available online in December 2020.

Robotics registration opens on **October 21, 2020** at **8:30 a.m.** and is administered on a first come, first serve basis.

Registration Procedure for Robotics

Your school must be registered with Skills Alberta to be able to participate. Registering as a Skills School is free of charge, visit skillsalberta.com and select “*Become a Skills School*” under the Resources tab.

The registration fee is \$100 per team. Invoices will be sent out following the event. Team withdrawals after **March 31, 2021** will be charged a \$60 cancellation fee.

Registration Steps:

- Login to the registration portal and select the “*Provincials*” tab.
- Once registration opens click on the green “*Add New*” button and select “*1 spot.*” A team of two will be added under “*Registered Participants/Teams*”.
- If a spot is not available or if you would like to request a spot for additional teams, click on the green “*Add New*” button in the Waitlist Request section.
- Enter in the students’ information in their team grouping. You will be required to provide each student’s first name, last name, parent/guardian’s name and email. An online consent form will be sent directly to the parent/guardian and will be marked as completed once it has been filled out. Do **not** press the “*Delete*” button unless you would like to remove your entire team and no longer wish to participate in the Robotics competition.
- All competitor information must be entered and all forms completed by the end of day on **April 5, 2021**.
