



ROBOTICS REGISTRATION 2021/22

Skills Canada Alberta is pleased to host Robotics as an event at the 2022 Provincial Skills Canada Competition (PSCC). Registration for Robotics opens earlier than the other events hosted at the PSCC due to the significant work required by students prior to the competition. **A NEW qualifying competition is being introduced this year to meet provincial demand.**

Registration for the Robotics Qualifying Competition opens on **October 20, 2021 at 8:30 a.m.** and is administered on a first come, first serve basis. Schools can register two teams to qualify against 45 teams for the PSCC. The Contest Description for the Robotics Qualifying Competition will be available online in October 2021 and the PSCC Contest Description in December 2021.

Registration Procedure for Robotics

Your school must be registered with Skills Alberta to be able to participate. Registering as a Skills School is free of charge, visit skillsalberta.com and select “*Become a Skills School*” under the Resources tab.

There is no fee to compete in the qualifying competition. The registration fee for the PSCC is \$100 per team. Invoices will be sent out following the event. Team withdrawals after **April 6, 2022** will be charged a \$60 cancellation fee.

Registration Steps:

- Login to the registration portal and select the “Qualifying Events” tab.
- Once registration opens click on the green “Add New” button and select “1 or 2.” A team of two will be added under “Registered Participants/Teams”.
- If a spot is not available or if you would like to request a spot for additional teams, click on the green “Add New” button in the Waitlist Request section.
- Enter in the students’ information in their team grouping. You will be required to provide each student’s first name, last name, parent/guardian’s name and email. An online consent form will be sent directly to the parent/guardian and will be marked as completed once it has been filled out. Do **not** press the “Delete” button unless you would like to remove your entire team and no longer wish to participate in the Robotics competition.
- All competitor information must be entered and all forms completed by the end of day on **January 17, 2022** or submissions will **not** be accepted.
- Qualifying Competition submissions are due January 19 by 4:00 p.m.
