# COMPETITION FORMAT: (VIRTUAL/ IN SCHOOL)

All secondary competitors will be competing with in their school environment and must arrange in advance with a teacher for a safe competition location, according to their school's Covid-19 safety policies. They will need to prepare their competition space with all of the required tools, equipment, materials, and technology (as listed below) that will be needed to complete the competition. Teachers and competitors will need to work together to ensure the competitor is ready for success on their competition day.

Each competitor must have a teacher/ supervisor available throughout the day, in case of incident. (Teacher/Supervisor must be present at the competition orientation.)

Competitors and Teachers should be prepared to receive additional information about the competition projects, livestreams, shipping, etc. prior to the competition. Please ensure you are double checking for emails from Skills, including checking junk mail.





# **WEBEX LIVESTREAMS:**

**Tech Check:** A "Tech Check" will take place prior to the competition with the purpose of giving the competitor an opportunity to ensure they have all of the necessary technology in place to join in their virtual orientation meeting the morning of their competition. On the competition day, there will be no time to work out technology issues. This is the opportunity work out any unforeseen issues and to start your competition day off prepared. There may also be an opportunity to ask questions regarding the competition day if time allows. An email with the WebEx link will be sent out in advance of the competition.

**Competition Orientation:** The competition will begin with a virtual orientation. Competitors will join the assigned videoconference link that will be emailed to all registered competitors for the competition orientation. Camera's MUST be on and competitors visible on the camera during the orientation. An email with the WebEx link will be sent out in advance of the competition.

Live Streamed Competition: Competitors must film their competition through out the entire day. Camera's MUST be on and competitors visible on the camera, as well as mics working. Competitors must consider their camera angle and lighting in advance of the competition. It is the competitors responsibility to ensure they are prepared for a day long livestream.

#### CONTEST INTRODUCTION

The competition also challenges students in hairstyling and promotes this career trade.

#### SKILLS AND KNOWLEDGE TO BE TESTED

- 1. Test 1 Men's Haircut and style from photo 1 hour and 15 minutes
- 2. Test 2 Ladies Long Hair Bridal from photo and reveled request 1 hour and 15 minutes
- 3. Test 3 Ladies Cut, Color and Style from inspiration pallet and reveled request 2 hours and 30 minutes

## **PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

The level of this competition will allow the young stylists to demonstrate their technical skills and creative ability in the following areas:

- 1. Haircutting scissors, razor, textures, and clippers.
- 2. Hairstyling setting & blow-drying
- 3. Long Hair Design
- 4. Creative Cosmetology/Ornamentation
- 5. Hair Coloring and De-Coloration semi-permanent and permanent.
- 6. Competition Styling





# **SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

In addition to livestreaming the video, students will be required to send in photos of their finished style suitable for posting to a social media account. Photos must represent front of style, back of style, and both left and right views. Submission details will be given to students during orientation.

#### **JUDGING CRITERIA**

No competitor will be judged by those who either know or have trained the competitor. Judging panel will consist of between 3-5 Alberta Journeyman Stylists. Test specific criteria is listed below.





#### Test 1 – MEN'S HAIRCUT and STYLE from Photo

#### **1hours 15 minutes**

The mannequin for this test is Antonio (no beard)

## **RATIONALE**

Competitors will be shown a photo and must reproduce the revealed view. The photo of the desired cut will be chosen by an independent panel of Alberta Hairstylists and will remain in a sealed envelope until the orientation for the competition.

# **Video requirements**

- Volume must remain on for the duration of the competition.
- Stylist must remain in the video view for the duration.
- Once time has been called stylist must show a close-up video in a circular motion of their finished project as explained in the orientation.

## **HAIRCUT**

# The mannequin must be unwashed and unaltered from shipping condition.

- The specific view of photo must be reproduced and the remaining elements of the haircut are to be determined by the stylist.
- Clippers and trimmers are allowed, but guards are not.
- No thermal irons allowed.
- Straight razor must have a guard.
- Brushes and/or combs and clips are permitted.
- All styling products are allowed (except colored sprays, colored mousse, colored gels, colored markers, crayons etc. cannot be used).

### **Photo Submission**

Mannequin must remain untouched from competition completion. If the mannequin has been altered from what was submitted during competition the competitor will earn 0 pts and be issued demerits.

Stylist must up load 5 pictures of their finished project. With the exception of the 5<sup>th</sup> photo, all photos must be close range, taken straight on (not above or below subject) with no filter.

## TIME

# 1hour 15 minutes

The mannequin for this test is Ingrid

## **RATIONALE**

This test represents a typically occurrence in the salon. The client comes in with a picture and an additional request. The photo and request will be determined by an independent panel of Alberta Hairstylists and will remain in a sealed envelope until the orientation of the competition. The finished style will reflect a commercial look.

The mannequin must be unwashed and unaltered from shipping condition at the start of the competition.

# **Video requirements**

- Volume must remain on for the duration of the competition.
- Stylist must remain in the video view for the duration.
- Once time has been called stylist must show a close-up video in a circular motion of their finished project as explained in the orientation.

# **COLOUR**

• In this test you are not allowed to use any color.



#### **FINISHED RESULT**

- Free choice of professional tools allowed. (Industry acceptable)
- No cutting implements or tweezers are allowed.
- Ornamentation will be provided and must be used.
- Hair fillers, padding or extensions are not allowed.
- Hair netting is not allowed.
- Colored sprays (including glitter), colored mousse, colored gels, colored markers, crayons etc. cannot be used.
- The hair is not to be cut.
- No dressing of the mannequin allowed.
- No penetrating pins into the head. Only use techniques you would use on a client to secure the hair or ornamentation. (See authentic Practice at the end of test 4)

## **Photo Submission**

Mannequin must remain untouched from competition completion. If the mannequin has been altered from what was submitted during competition the competitor will earn 0 pts and be issued demerits.

Stylist must up load 5 pictures of their finished project. With the exception of the 5th photo, all photos must be close range, taken straight on (not above or below subject) with no filter.

- Stylist must remain in the video view for the duration. This includes areas of color selection, mixing, and takedown.
- Once time has been called stylist must show a close-up video in a circular motion of their finished project as explained in the orientation.



# 2021 PROVINCIAL SKILLS CANADA COMPETITION Skills Canada Alberta

## **RATIONALE**

This haircut and color must reflect a commercial haircut color and style typically performed in a salon. The inspirational pallet for color choice and incorporation WILL be from one of the 5 options provided. The options are meant to guide the stylist and stylists are discouraged to attempt to duplicate the styles and cuts represented. The selection of the color inspiration will happen during orientation as will the one request for an element in the haircut. The inspiration and request will be made by an independent panel of Alberta Hairstylists and will remain in a sealed envelope until the orientation for the competition. Once revealed by the PTC Chair, the competitors may not confer with anyone. This test must respect industry standards. (Color inspiration options are attached)

This mannequin was used in test 2 and therefore can be washed and in a wet or dried state prior to the start of the competition time. No precutting or coloring may occur.

## **HAIRCUT**

- The selected request must be present and visible.
- All cutting techniques and tools are allowed.

## **COLOUR**

- Commercial and wearable by a majority not a rare few.
- All coloring techniques are allowed.
- All color products are allowed to be used in this test with the exception of colored sprays (including glitter), colored mousse, colored gels, colored markers, crayons etc. cannot be used.
- The selected inspiration color pallet must be present and visible. (see Attached)
- All hair must have a noticeable change of color

# **Photo Submission**

Mannequin must remain untouched from competition completion. If the mannequin has been altered from what was submitted during competition the competitor will earn 0 pts and be issued demerits.

Stylist must up load 4 pictures of their finished project. With the exception of the 5th photo, all photos must be close range, taken straight on (not above or below subject) with no filter.

Any communication verbal or otherwise between competitor and others

# **Sustainability**

# **Safety**

Failure to sweep up hair immediately after cutting. Professional sanitary practices must be followed. Industry safety protocols must be followed. No platform or high heel shoes. Socks or hosiery must be worn. All SDS sheets must be available if requested.

Tiebreaker #1: The competitor with the highest score in test 3

Tiebreaker #2: The competitor with the highest score in test 1.

# **CLOTHING REQUIREMENT**

Appropriate work clothing must be worn to compete. All clothing must be neat and clean, and free of rips and tears. Casual wear such as shorts and open toed shoes/sandals will not be permitted. No loose-fitting clothes or jewelry.




