Competition Info:

Familiarise yourself with the plan for the project. (The latest plans are dated April 2021 in the title box.) If possible, please print them on 11x17 paper for clarity. Plan your procedure to complete the project in the time allotted. You may go over this with your teacher to get their input.

Go over the Evaluation Sheet for the project to see how you will be judged.

You will need to take pictures of your project so be sure you have lighting and a steady hand to take these. The quality of the pictures will give me a chance to judge the project fairly. If the picture is out of focus, I will judge it as accurately as I can.

Check your material as soon as you get it. You should have 5 pieces. Each piece has been machined to the finished thickness (16mm) and the following widths:

- 2@ 155mm
- 1@ 50mm
- 1@ 100mm
- 1@ 150mm

The pieces are long and will need to be cut to final dimensions. This is part of the competition and needs to be done during the timed portion.

A guide will be sent to you from Skills Canada Alberta regarding the pictures that need to be submitted for judging.
