- Paper Plate/ Tray






Quickly roll the wax into a worm shape.
Work fast so it doesn't disintegrate!



Lay the wax onto the skin and spread it out flat



Option to use a small amount of Vaseline to smooth the edges



Create a cut effect using a snapped popsicle stick



Add blood to the inside of the cut



Gradually build up the blood




First, select an inspiration image to work from



Pluck the edges of the sponge to get a more organic shape



Lightly add paint to the sponge and gently pat onto skin



Add heavier paint spots to create depth to the bruise
