What You Will Need

- Tape Measure
- Pencil
- Clamp
- Drill
- Drill Bit (1/8 inch)
- Screwdriver

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Hole Drilling Locations

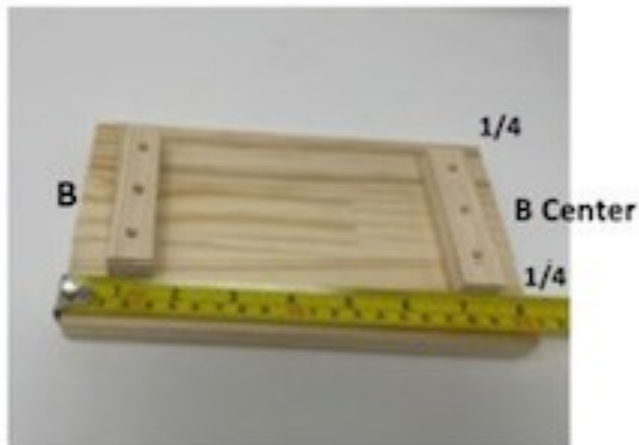
Please use a 0.125 sized drill bit to create the holes as laid out below using a 1/8 drill bit



- A) Picnic Tabletop – 3 Boards
- B) Tabletop Brace – 2 Pieces
- C) Legs – 4 Wood with Angled Edges
- D) Side Seat Supports – 2 Long Pieces
- E) Seat – 2 Boards
- F) Sandpaper
- G) Screws – 18 Total

Hole Locations:

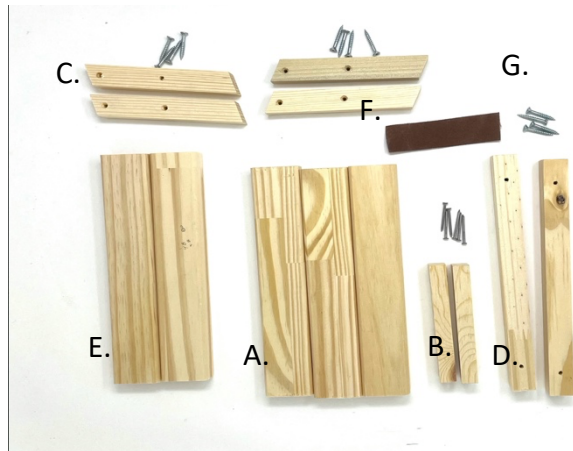
- On the 4 legs (C) you will drill a hole in the center of the leg as well as 1/4 inch from the end of the leg
- On the 2 side seat supports (D) you will drill a hole 1/4 inch from each end
- For the 2 the table braces you will drill a hole in the center and a 1/4 inch from each end



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Please Note: Great care has been taken to pre-drill and cut components to size. Slight variations in material size, density and hole location are inevitable when dealing with wood. The user may be required to adjust and make material fit.

***Sand all pieces to remove any chances of splinter and do not over tighten**



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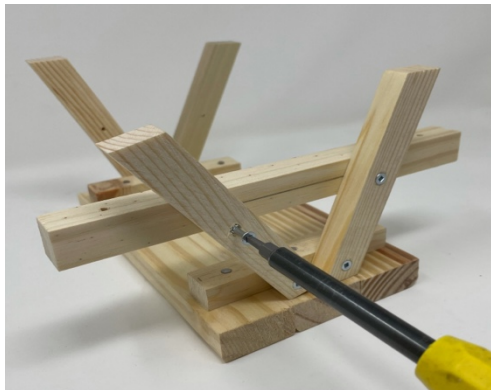
Tools Required: Robertson #2 and a Ruler



Step 1: Take the 3 Tabletop Pieces (A) and place them upside down (rounded side down), measure 1 inch, and secure the brace (B) with screws (G) on each side



Step 2: Install all 4 legs (C) using screws into pre-drilled holes securing to the tabletop brace



Step 3: Next install the seat supports (D) place the support inside of the legs and screw into the pre-drilled holes on the legs into the side supports.



Step 4: To install the seats (E) it's best to place the seat upside down (rounded side down) on the edge of your workstation, then with the picnic table upside down, place the seat supports onto the seats and secure in place with screws into the predrilled holes



Step 5: Completed Squirrel Picnic Table
