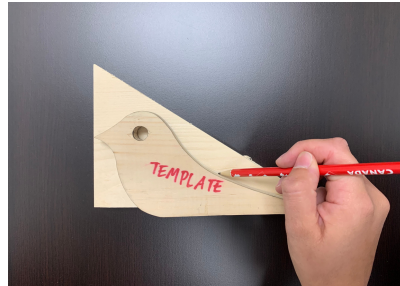

Don't forget your personal protective equipment before you start! This includes a mask, safety gloves and glasses.

Let's Get to Work!



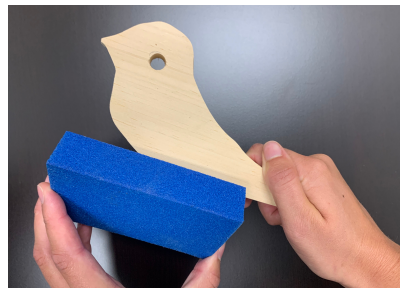
Trace around the bird template on the 2x4 wooden piece



Clamp the wood piece onto a solid surface and line up the power drill to drill the eye hole



Cut out the bird shape using a scroll saw



Sand the bird using a palm or block sander to create nice smooth edges



Once the bird is sanded, decorate however you wish!
