HOLD UP!

Don't forget your personal protective equipment before you start! This includes a mask, safety gloves and glasses.



Let's Get to Work!

Front & back pieces

10mm

Identify the project layout on the front and back piece (10mm in from the bottom of the piece)



Apply glue to the rabbets and add the front to the bottom piece using nails

Side pieces

10mm

10mm

10mm

Identify the layout on the side pieces (10 mm in from the bottom and sides of the piece)



Assemble one side, the back piece and additional side piece



Identify the nail holes on all pieces



Finish off your project by removing the glue and sanding the wood
