CONTEST INTRODUCTION

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Competitors will be required to demonstrate their knowledge and skills by completing a twopiece collar with a placket opening, using the pattern provided, as well as a sample welt pocket of your choosing. Competitors will submit their finished products by mailing them in to be judged. The most successful competitors will move on to compete in the Secondary Skills Alberta Virtual Competition.

SKILLS AND KNOWLEDGE TO BE TESTED

- Accuracy in tracing, sewing, cutting
- Ability to construct a collar, placket, and welt pocket with clean corners and symmetrical points

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

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Competitors must submit the constructed two-piece collar with a placket opening using the printable pattern provided as well as a sample welt pocket. The pocket can be either a single welt or double welt and the length and width will be determined by the applicant. Industry sewing standards for garment construction to be maintained as equipment allows.

INSPIRE. DEVELOP. ELEVATE.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- One completed collar with placket and a sample welt pocket.
- The project must be shipped by February 21, 2022 in order to be considered for marking. Submission MUST be sent through OVERNGHT OR PRIORITY mail. Shipping costs can be reimbursed by filling out the <u>Fashion Technology Qualifier Subsidy Form</u> by February 28, 2022 (receipts required.)
