# **CONTEST INTRODUCTION**

Competitors will be required to demonstrate their knowledge and skills by completing two sample welt pockets. Competitors will submit their finished products by mailing them in to be judged.

# **NO PATTERN WILL BE PROVIDED**

### SKILLS AND KNOWLEDGE TO BE TESTED

- Accuracy in sewing & cutting
- Ability to construct a welt pocket with clean corners and symmetrical points
- Use of Fusing
- single and double welt construction

# Johnson's Sewing Centre

### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Competitors must submit 2 sample welt pockets. The pockets will be one single welt and one double welt. The length and width will be 1"X 5" for each pocket opening. Welts must fill the opening and be symmetrical. Industry sewing standards for garment construction to be maintained as equipment allows.

- Two sample welt pockets.
