Congratulations! You have earned a position to compete in the Provincial Skills Canada Competition (PSCC) on May 3-4, 2023 at the Edmonton EXPO Centre.

The PSCC is an annual event hosted by Skills Canada Alberta to showcase students excelling in their chosen trade or technology. Students will compete in one of 45 trade and technology events in a two-day Olympic-style competition. This event gives the community an exceptional opportunity to see trade and technology careers in practice, and gives students the chance to challenge their knowledge and abilities. Selected medalists from the PSCC are also invited to join Team Alberta to participate at the Skills Canada National Competition, May 24-27, 2023 in Winnipeg, MB.

- Following the Opening Ceremony you will receive your registration package. Competitors unable to attend the Opening Ceremonies may register on May 3, 2023 between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m.
- Attend your **mandatory orientation.** Some orientations will take place on the evening of May 3, some will take place on the morning of May 4. Make sure to check your Contest Description for your orientation time. Orientations are mandatory. If a competitor misses mandatory orientation, this may result in the forfeit of their spot.
- Remember to invite your family, friends, coworkers and employers to watch you compete in this exciting event. Admission and parking are FREE!
- The Awards Ceremony will be hosted at the Edmonton EXPO Centre on May 4, at 6:30 p.m. where the gold, silver and bronze medals for each competition will be awarded. Bring your friends and family to cheer you on! The Awards Ceremony will be livestreamed for anyone to watch online at SkillsAlberta.com.



Skills Canada National Competition Winnipeg, MB, May 23-27, 2023

The list below indicates which 2023 PSCC events will advance a secondary representative to the Skills Canada National Competition (SCNC). PSCC Gold Medal winners will be asked to commit their attendance to the SCNC backstage at the Awards Ceremony. Your students must be present at the PSCC Awards Ceremony to claim their spot on Team Alberta. If the student cannot attend the PSCC Awards Ceremony, please email Javierad@SkillsAlberta.com prior to May 1, 2023 to indicate his or her interest in participating in SCNC. If attendance is not confirmed or the individual is not present at the Awards Ceremony, Skills Canada Alberta reserves the right to select an alternate representative.

Secondary students must have a chaperone or supervisor accompany them. Skills Canada Alberta is not responsible for the supervision of students at the PSCC or SCNC.

Due to the short time frame between the PSCC and SCNC we recommend that students/teachers review both the PSCC Contest Description at www.skillsalberta.com and the SCNC Contest Description on www.skillscanada.com before the PSCC and are prepared for both.

Team Alberta 2023

We highly encourage you to create a plan ahead of the PSCC to confirm your students are prepared to accept the position to be on Team Alberta and participate at the Skills Canada National Competition. Students must be prepared to commit immediately following their receipt of the gold medal. With travel days, the full commitment of the Skills Canada National Competition is May 23-27, 2023.

The cost for competitors to attend the Skills Canada National Competition in Winnipeg is approximately **\$1275** for double occupancy, and for chaperones/teachers it is approximately **\$1750** for single occupancy. This cost includes air and ground transportation, hotel, accreditation fees, Team Alberta uniform, and some meals. Although SCA has heavily subsidized the fee to participate, we recognize the cost is significant and hope that by providing this advanced notice, you will not miss an opportunity to be involved in this important event!
