Skills Canada Alberta (SCA) equips young minds with the skills to succeed in a changing economic environment. SCA is a not-for-profit, provincial association, which works with employers, educators, labour groups and government partners to emphasize trade and technology careers as first choice career options.

Each year, Skills Canada Alberta hosts the Provincial Skills Canada Competition, which highlights secondary and post-

secondary students in an Olympic-style skilled trades and technologies competition.

STATIC BOOTHS (NO HANDS-ON ACTIVITY)

INTERACTIVE BOOTHS (HANDS-ON ELEMENT)

Interactive booths incorporate a hands-on activity that showcases an aspect of trades or technology, to meaningfully engage students. Please note: flyers do not count as an interactive element.


Examples of successful interactive Skill City booths include:

BOOTH OPTION

The cost for the two day event is \$1500 for an interactive booth or \$2000 for a static booth. Skills Canada Alberta will provide the following (per booth):
