Team Alberta 2024

We highly encourage you to create a plan ahead of the PSCC to confirm your students are prepared to accept the position to be on Team Alberta and participate at the Skills Canada National Competition. Students must be prepared to commit immediately following their receipt of the gold medal. With travel days, the full commitment of the Skills Canada National Competition is May 27—June 1, 2024.

The cost for competitors to attend the Skills Canada National Competition in is approximately \$1475 for double occupancy, and for chaperones/teachers it is approximately \$2050 for single occupancy. This cost includes air and ground transportation, hotel, accreditation fees, Team Alberta uniform, and some meals. Although SCA has heavily subsidized the fee to participate, we recognize the cost is significant and hope that by providing this advanced notice, you will not miss an opportunity to be involved in this important event!
