FIRST STEPS ON TEAM ALBERTA

Please follow the below instructions to secure your Team Alberta spot to attend the Skills Canada National Competition (SCNC):

- ♦ Step One: Confirm that you will accept your spot on Team Alberta by filling out the <u>Team AB Registration Form</u>. It is important that registration forms are filled out immediately upon receiving your place on Team Alberta. All registration and documents are due by Sunday, May 12 at 11:59 PM. Failure to complete these forms correctly and on time could result in losing your spot on Team Alberta.
- **Step Two:** Visit the <u>SCNC website</u> to view your contest description, project documents and schedule, and sign up for updates.
- Step Three: Visit the SCA Team Alberta webpage for all important competition information and links.
- Step Four: Download Slack to your phone and connect to the Team AB conversation.

It is your responsibility to stay up to date with all competition and trip information and requirements. SCA will provide you with all of the information you need through the Team AB package (this document), the Team AB Webpage, and Slack.



PAYMENT INFORMATION

Skills Canada Alberta is responsible for booking ALL travel and accommodations for secondary competitors, secondary chaperones, and post-secondary competitors. Competitor packages are **\$1475** and chaperone packages are **\$2050**. Competitors and chaperones must confirm with their school how fees will be covered.

TEAM ALBERTA UNIFORM

Each competitor will receive a black Team Alberta shirt and jacket. You must wear an item of the team uniform on competition day(s) at the SCNC. Black pants/skirt and black shoes must be worn with the Team Alberta jacket at the opening and closing ceremonies.

FLIGHTS

Competitors will depart either from Edmonton or Calgary based on availability. Skills Alberta staff members will greet you at the airport and assist you with the check-in process. Please confirm your flight times with the airline prior to departure to ensure there haven't been any changes.

TEAM ALBERTA TRAVEL INFORMATION

LUGGAGE

One 50lbs bag with a maximum linear dimension of 62 in (158 cm) is included with your flight but you are responsible for all additional baggage fees including overweight charges. Oversized* luggage must be under 70lbs per item and measure 63 to 115 in (160 to 292 cm). All lithium batteries must be carried onto the plane – this includes computer batteries (check desktop for watch batteries), power tool batteries, etc. For more details, visit <u>Air Canada's website</u>.

Please Note: If your toolbox or luggage is oversized it will need to be shipped via air cargo at your expense. Requirements for Air Cargo may need to be made in advance. Ensure your review air cargo requirements here: Shipping via air cargo

SCNC COMPETITION INFORMATION

COMPETITION DOCUMENTS

Team Alberta competitors are required to review the contest description, project, and supplementary information available on the <u>SCNC website</u>. Information regarding your competition can be found online. Please thoroughly review all documents to ensure that you understand and are prepared for the tasks you will be required to do. Competitors are responsible for ensuring they have all the required tools and equipment, safety supplies, and technology noted in the contest description. It is the responsibility of the Team Alberta competitor to ensure they are working off the **most current documents** for their specific event.

TOOLBOX DROP OFF AND PICK UP

Toolbox drop off will take place on Tuesday, May 27, prior to the team dinner and activity at the Sugar Shack. We will leave the hotel at 3:30 PM to bus to the competition site, where competitors will be responsible for unloading their toolboxes. All toolboxes must be labelled and checked-in, and will be brought to the skill area by SCNC staff. Toolboxes must be securely labeled with SCC Competitor Toolbox Label prior to venue drop off.

Once you have checked-in your toolbox, you will not be permitted to remove them until the competition has finished. Competitors are responsible for removing their toolbox/equipment from their skill area and transporting it back to the hotel at the end of the competition on May 31, 2024.


COMPETITOR ORIENTATION

SCNC competitor orientation will take place on Wednesday May 29 from 4:30 –5:45 PM in respective skills areas. Orientations are mandatory for all competitors. The meeting is designed to prepare competitors for their contests. The National Technical Committee will provide instructions in the official language of the competitor's choice.

This review will include:

- Confirming attendance and competitor information, and allocate station numbers
- Rules of the event, schedule, evaluation criteria, grievance process, safety procedures
- Verify tool list and material that competitors must supply
- An opportunity for competitors to ask questions about tools, equipment and materials

The National Technical Committee allows the presence of advisors (delegates) and interpreters during this meeting.
