### FIRST STEPS ON TEAM ALBERTA

Please follow the below instructions to secure your Team Alberta spot to attend the Skills Canada National Competition (SCNC):

- Step One: Visit the <u>SCA Team Alberta webpage</u> for all important competition information and links.
- ◆ Step Two: Confirm that you will accept your spot on Team Alberta by filling out the <u>Team AB Registration Form</u>. It is important that registration forms are filled out immediately upon receiving your place on Team Alberta. All registration and documents are due by Sunday, May 11 at 11:59 PM. Failure to complete these forms correctly and on time could result in losing your spot on Team Alberta.
- Step Three: Download <u>Slack</u> to your phone and connect to the Team AB conversation.
- **Step Four:** Visit the <u>SCNC website</u> to view your contest description, project documents and schedule, and sign up for updates.

It is your responsibility to stay up to date with all competition and trip information and requirements. SCA will provide you with all of the information you need through this Team AB package, the Team AB Webpage, and Slack.



#### PAYMENT INFORMATION

SCA is responsible for booking ALL travel and accommodations for secondary competitors, secondary chaperones, and post-secondary competitors only. Competitor packages are \$995. and chaperone packages are \$1950. Competitors and chaperones must confirm with their school how fees will be covered. Invoices will be sent to all schools directly after the SCNC.

#### **TEAM ALBERTA UNIFORM**

Each competitor will receive a Team Alberta shirt and jacket. You must wear an item of the team uniform on competition day(s) at the SCNC. Black pants/skirt and black shoes must be worn with the Team Alberta jacket at the opening and closing ceremonies.

#### **FLIGHT INFO**

Competitors and chaperones will depart either from Edmonton or Calgary, based on availability.

Team Alberta will be flying with Summit Air, a private charter airline.

Please note the below **PRIVATE** airport terminal locations. Paid parking is available at each location.

SCA staff members will greet you at the airport and assist you with the check-in process. SCA will notify you directly with any flight status changes prior to departure.

#### **LUGGAGE (Regular & Oversized)**

Each passenger will be allowed:

- One checked medium-sized 39lb (maximum) bag
- One personal carry-on item that will tuck under your seat or fit in a small overhead bin (10lb maximum, ex. purse/small backpack.

A limited number of contest areas may require oversized luggage. If this is you, please contact SCA as soon as possible so we can make arrangements to ensure there is space for your luggage. Please email Mikes@skillsalberta.com to make arrangements no later than May 11th, 2025. Oversized pieces cannot exceed 50lbs per piece and cannot exceed 53"x28". All oversized luggage must be approved by SCA. All lithium batteries must be carried onto the plane – this includes computer batteries (check desktop for watch batteries), power tool batteries, etc.

Summit Air has strict weight and size restrictions that SCA must follow, therefore all information about luggage and oversized items will be collected by SCA prior to the flight. Any items not divulged prior to the flight may not be permitted onto the plane.

### SCNC COMPETITION INFORMATION

#### **COMPETITION DOCUMENTS**

Team Alberta competitors are required to review the contest description, project, and supplementary information available on the <u>SCNC website</u>. Information regarding your competition can be found online. Please review all documents to ensure that you understand and are prepared for the tasks you will be required to do. Competitors are responsible for ensuring they have all the required tools and equipment, safety supplies, and technology noted in the contest description. It is the responsibility of the Team Alberta competitor to ensure they are working off the **most current documents** for their specific event.

#### **TOOLBOX DROP OFF AND PICK UP**

Toolbox drop off will take place on Tuesday, May 27, prior to checking into the hotel. All toolboxes must be labelled and checked-in, and will be brought to the skill area by SCNC staff. Toolboxes must be securely labeled with the SCC Competitor Toolbox Label prior to venue drop off.


Once you have checked in your toolbox, you will not be permitted to remove it until the competition has finished. Competitors are responsible for removing their toolbox/equipment from their skill area and transporting it back to the hotel at the end of the competition.

#### COMPETITOR ORIENTATION

SCNC competitor orientation will take place on Wednesday May 28 from 2:00 PM –3:15 PM in respective skills areas. Orientations are mandatory for all competitors. The meeting is designed to prepare competitors for their contests. The National Technical Committee will provide instructions in the official language of the competitor's choice.

This review will include:

- Confirming attendance and competitor information, and allocating station numbers.
- Rules of the event, schedule, evaluation criteria, grievance process, and safety procedures.
- Verifying tool list and material that competitors must supply.
- An opportunity for competitors to ask questions about tools, equipment and materials.
