Topic/Task	Contest Specific Rule
Use of Technology	Competitors are <b>not allowed</b> laptops, tablets, cameras, cell phones, ear buds, calculators or other personal electronics in the competition area unless specified by the committee for certain tasks.
Use of Artificial	Competitors cannot use AI to develop/generate any of the submitted
Intelligence (AI)	work for any aspects of the competition.

#### **CLOTHING REQUIREMENT**

It is important that competitors present a professional image and appearance. Appropriate work clothing must be worn to compete. All clothing must be neat and clean and free of rips and tears. Casual wear such as shorts will not be permitted. No loose-fitting clothes or jewelry.
