

Team Alberta 2026 Discord Server Guide

Welcome to the Team Alberta 2026 Discord Server! This is the place where you'll get updates, event and meetup reminders, answers to your questions, opportunities to chat with fellow Team Alberta competitors, and more.

Step 1: Download Discord

Before joining the Team Alberta server, download the Discord app for free from your phone's app store.

Once Discord is installed:

- Use the invite link provided to join the Team Alberta server.
- If you scan the QR code, it should bring you directly to the app store if Discord is not already downloaded.

Step 2: Set Your Server Name

It is very important that your name on the Team Alberta server is set to your **first and last name**.

This helps organizers:

- Know who you are
- Place everyone into the correct categories
- Message the right people when needed

Already have a Discord username or gamertag you love? That's okay — you can change your name for this server only.

How to Change Your Name for This Server

1. Open the Team Alberta server
2. Click the server's name in the top-left corner
3. Select **Edit Per-Server Profile**
4. Change your display name to your first and last name

This only changes your name in the Team Alberta server. Your username will stay the same everywhere else.

Step 3: Stay Updated with Event Notifications

Discord has a built-in event system to help you stay informed.

To make sure you don't miss important meetups or activities:

1. Click **Events** in the top-left corner of the server
2. Find the events that apply to you
3. Click **Interested**

When you mark an event as "Interested," Discord will send you a reminder about 15 minutes before it starts.

This is very important, so please make sure you select **Interested** in relevant events.

Step 4: Manage Notifications

Getting too many notifications? You can customize your notification settings for specific channels.

We recommend changing busy channels to **Mentions Only**.

How to Adjust Notifications

1. Click the server's name in the top-left corner
2. Select **Notification Settings**
3. Scroll down to **Select a channel or category**
4. Choose the channel you want to adjust
5. Set notifications to **Mentions**
6. Click **Done** to save your settings

You can repeat this process for multiple channels.

Important Channels to Keep Notifications On

Please keep notifications enabled for these important channels:

- **Transportation**
- **Announcements-updates**
- **Resources**

These channels are only used for important information and updates.

Fun & Social Channels

Discord is also a space to connect with your teammates.

General Chats

These channels are meant for conversations, sharing experiences, and planning hangouts:

- **general chat**
- **introductions**
- **photos and moments**
- **schedule-hangout**

Voice Channels

Voice channels allow you to:

- Join calls with teammates
- Play games added to the server
- Use the whiteboard feature
- Hang out during downtime

A Quick Reminder

Discord is meant to be a fun, welcoming, and supportive space for Team Alberta competitors. Please be respectful, inclusive, and kind when chatting with others. This server is a place to build connections, support one another, ask questions, and enjoy the Team Alberta experience together!
